Orange City to Give Away 100 Trees to Celebrate 20th Year as Tree City USA

ORANGE CITY – Orange City’s designation as “Tree City USA” means some residents will be getting free trees.

On Friday, April 29, 2022, the city plans to give away 100 one-gallon trees in celebration of its 20th year as an active member of the Arbor Day Foundation’s Tree City USA program. Willow Oak, Winged Elm, American Sycamore and Bald Cypress will be the tree varieties available. Each household is eligible to receive one free tree on a first-come, first-served basis. Proof of Orange City residency is required (e.g. driver’s license or utility bill).

The giveaway will take place at Coleman Park, 210 E Blue Springs Ave, Orange City, Fla. Additionally, City staff will be available to help educate residents on the placement of trees as well as proper care and maintenance.
